Ryde Arts are excited to announce a new commission for the Ryde HAZ (Heritage Action Zone) cultural project; *Waving the Flag*.

Following the success of our 2022 poster, designed by local artist Pete Bradley, we are again looking for an artist to provide new original artwork for the 2023 Ryde Carnival season. The artwork will be used for a range of marketing purposes including (but not limited to) posters, merchandise, digital merchandising and television placement. We would also like the posters to be available as signed, collectable, limited edition prints on high quality archival paper.

Waving The Flag is a collaborative project between locally based cultural organisations; Ryde Carnival Association, Ryde Arts, New Carnival Company and Shademakers. Waving the Flag is three year project funded by Historic England, Arts Council England and Heritage Lottery as part of the Ryde Heritage Action Zone initiative.
